

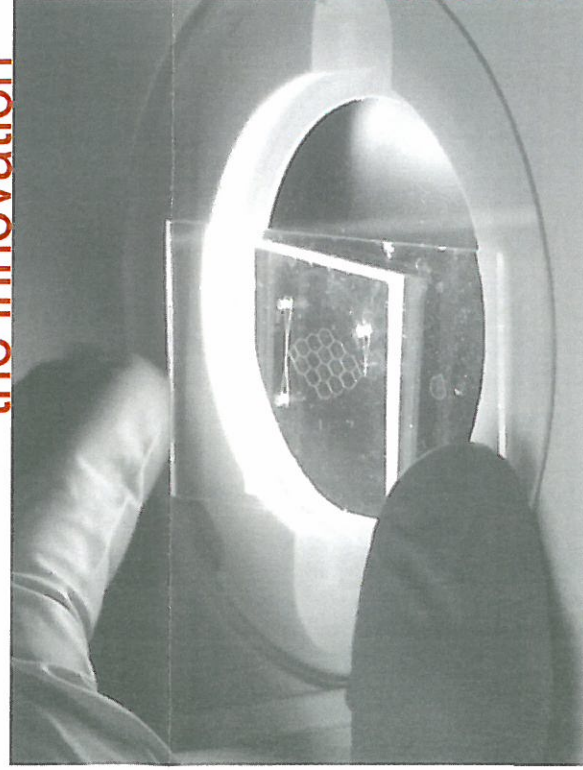

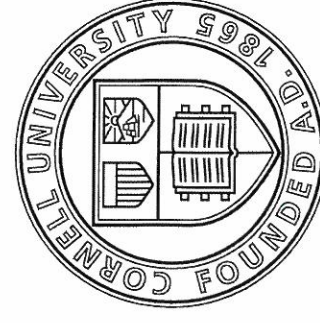

ADMISSION NOTIFICATION:

ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Current freshmen, sophomores, and juniors
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Completed application must be accompanied by a:
 - Typed essay of 500 words maximum explaining the following:
 - *Why the applicant wants to participate in the CATALYST program*
 - *What he/she hopes to gain from the experience*
 - *What interests him/her about engineering*
 - *What thoughts he/she has about his/her future career*
 - Written recommendation from a math or science teacher or a high school counselor
 - Official high school transcript
 - High school profile
